	• Los Angeles County Public Works ○ Highway 138 Intersection Upgrades and Awareness • 50th and Possible Final Ducktoberfest • Association of Rural Town Councils (ARTC) – Jose C.	▪ CERT - having an event at AV Fairgrounds on 10/04/2025 for CERT members. • Liberty and the Sexual Violent Predator (SVP) – a.k.a. “The Pillowcase Rapist” – Mary Jeters ○ Kathryn Barger made a motion to the Board of Supervisors to support the bills to stop placing SVPs in our valley. ▪ SB379 proposes to makes public safety a required consideration and have to sign-off on the location prior to placement of an SVP. ▪ SB380 proposes instead of immediate placement they be placed in transitional housing, preferably on the grounds of the mental hospital ▪ 4 out of 5 supervisors supported them and it passed ○ On 07/04/2025 we had a Community BBQ with some representatives, community members, and all the local Town Councils. ○ The SVP placed in Lancaster had his progress report hearing and he said he wants to have unconditional release within the community. He had some issues because the Department of State Hospitals wanted him to have a community services component which Liberty Healthcare didn’t want him serving in the community. His hearing is on 08/28/2025 to see if he can petition to go to trial. Not sure if jury or just with the judge. He was convicted of raping young girls in many states. ○ Joint Legislators Audit Committee Hearing. Audit hearing that was done in July of the SVP program. There wasn’t anything conclusive but they are aware of how much money per SVP around \$493,000 to keep in the community vs. around \$390,000 to stay in the State Hospital. ○ The Littlerock SVP hearing people were concerned that he was seen driving around alone. He still has security guards at night and he has a curfew. His annual hearing is coming up in October and anticipated to petition for unconditional release. ○ There was a scare of another predator placement in our area. The placement was pulled for now. Doesn’t mean we won’t get more. ○ Pillowcase Rapist had his progress report hearing last week and no one could get on the call because they changed how it was to be viewed at the last minute. The Judge said he is so happy that he is gardening and hopes he can get some community service and that was pretty much it. Next hearing 09/18/2025. ○ Did an appreciation event to celebrate all the officials that have been

		○ assisting with this process. ○ Alpine Range – trying to get it reopened if anyone is interested in helping with the efforts let her know. ● Pearblossom Highway 138 ○ Signal Light – 126th Street - construction happening that we are receiving the signal. Process was started in 2019. In 2018 we requested it we were told once construction was completed we requested a traffic study. The traffic study was performed by Cal Trans and the bulk of the traffic and school buses wait time (often 20 minutes) to turn on the highway was on 126th Street. Currently there is no safe place to cross in the middle of town. ○ Highway 138 Safe Roads Initiative Tour ■ A way to help Juan Carrillo's and Kathryn Barger's office to understand the situation from Littlerock to the county line. Started at 82st Street to show how busy it is there, spoke on the risks of adding a truck stop there. Went to 96th Street then to 106th Street shared the importance on how the towns have to cross the highway at these intersection. 106th Street is very dangerous because it is on a curve. Everyone we could bring up to show the importance of safety. ■ Went down to 165th Street to show the high speed area showed them at night how the reflectors are too worn and can't see and there is no stop light for a very long distance without any warning it is coming up.
